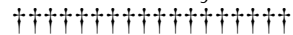


Total Ministry at Gloria Dei, it's each to your own ministry. Mine is to assist elderly people who are trying to stay in their homes.

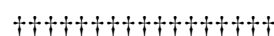


WE REMEMBER IN PRAYER: John Mangas is receiving physical therapy at North Haven Nursing Center.
